Characterization T-Shirt: Choose one character from *Of Mice and Men* and identify aspects of their character used by the author use of characterization and literary elements.

Front of T-Shirt

Summary of the character:

- □ Internal/External Conflicts
- Static/Dynamic Character (Explanation in presentation)
- Round/Flat Character (Explanation in presentation)

- □ Example of direct characterization

- □ Identify their ideas or beliefs
- □ Identify their vision of hope (or lack thereof)
- □ Identify significant actions
- □ Identify significant feelings

Theme Poster: Identify **one theme** that is evident in *Of Mice and Men.* Explain the importance of this theme and how it connects to **three examples** from the characters, plot, and/or setting of the novel. You must have **one image/symbol that represents each of the examples and a detailed explanation for each.** <u>You must also explain why this theme is an important</u> <u>universal lesson to learn.</u>

Example: Loneliness is a common topic from the novel and what we learn is that **loneliness can have negative effects.** Some examples from the novel are Crooks mental capacity, Curley's wife's' need for attention—too trusting

Argumentative Essay: Answer the question: Was George justified in killing Lennie? Defend or opposes George's decision to kill Lennie.

Requirements

- □ Write a thesis that is **clear**, **logical**, and **arguable**.
- □ Support your opinion with at least **THREE** logical and convincing **reasons.**
- □ Develop those reasons with **details**, **examples**, and/or **analogies**. Use quotations from the text to support your reasoning.
- □ You must also include a rebuttal. Anticipate the reasons of the other side of the argument.
- □ Aim for 1.5 to 2 pages. Typed or hand written. If handwritten must be neat and professional. If typed must be 1.5 spaced. Only **hard copy NO EMAILS OR GOOGLE SHARES.**

Essay Structure:

□ Introduction:

- Must hook the reader.
- $\circ~$ Give context of novel and situation at hand.
- Move from general to specific. State thesis: Which position you take.

Each Body Paragraph: (3)

- For each paragraph, focus on a supporting argument. Each must have a clear topic sentence and transitional devices, supporting examples/explanation, and a conclusion.
- Order arguments from weakest to strongest.
- Make concessions early so that you have time to refute them.

\Box Conclusion:

- Reiterate thesis and summarize main points.
- Explain significance of issue (relate to reader).

You will pick numbers to determine the order of presentations.

You must wear your shirt on day of presentation—present shirt and poster. Extra credit if you want to read your argument.
