## The Necklace Group Activity

Each person in each group will have a component to focus on.

- 1. Exposition and conflict
- 2. Rising Action and Climax
- 3. Falling Action and Resolution
- 4. Theme and Irony
- 1. Exposition and conflict: Give background information. Identify characters: Protagonist and Antagonist. Identify if they are dynamic or static, round or flat. Identify the conflict and what type of conflict. Identify the setting.
- 2. Rising Action and Climax: Identify and summarize the events that led up to the climax. Identify the climax and explain how this is the turning point.
- 3. Falling Action and Resolution: Identify and summarize the events that follow the climax. Identify the resolution and how everything is resolved.
- 4. Theme and Irony: Identify the theme and give evidence that supports your theme. Identify what type of irony is exhibited and explain.

You are going to create a poster with the following. For each you need to have a visual or symbol that relates to the topic (ex. Exposition) and the story.
